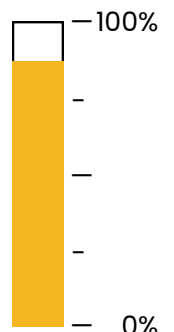

SAINT OF THE WEEK

NOVEMBER 3RD

SAINT MARTIN DE PORRES
(1579-1639)

Religious

An old illustration pictures Martin de Porres, finger to his lips—"Shhhh!"—as several mice peek out of sacristy vestment drawers, preparing to join a rodent "procession" following him out of church! Martin's rescue of these unwelcome "guests," and statues depicting him, broom in hand, feeding a dog, cat, bird, and mouse from the same dish symbolize his life and sanctity. Initially denied entrance by the Dominicans because of "mixed race"

Martin cherished society's marginalized. For him, menial tasks, lovingly done, were sacred. Great and lowly alike feasted on his charity. Enemies were reconciled by this "poor mulatto" (his self-description), kind even to those whose racism demeaned him. Apprenticed to a surgeon-barber in his youth—thus patron saint of hair stylists and public health providers—Martin dispensed healing and dignity to Lima's poorest serving in them the Christ he adored for hours in the

Blessed Sacrament. By the time he died, all Peru called him "Martin the Charitable," a title even those of us who will never be called "saint" might still aspire to.

The Church Suffering

One of the most beautiful aspects of our Catholic faith is the Communion of Saints. Whether we belong to the Church Militant still fighting the good fight on earth, the Church Suffering enduring purification in Purgatory, or the Church Triumphant rejoicing with our Lord in Heaven, we are all united in faith. We are one Church, joined together in the mysteries of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. What makes this reality so moving is our ability to pray for one another, no matter our state of life. Those on earth can pray to lessen the time in Purgatory for their brothers and sisters; those in Purgatory can offer their sufferings

for souls on earth; and those in Heaven can intercede for both. It is an incredible circle of love and mercy that will continue until Christ comes again. Today we remember the Church Suffering—"those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith." In other words, all our departed brothers and sisters

baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Because our souls must be completely cleansed before entering the heavenly banquet, many will experience this purification after death, while others are purified through the trials and sufferings of earthly life, aided by the

grace of the sacraments. We may wonder why our aunt endures Alzheimer's, why our grandfather suffers the burdens of old age, or why our nephew or child must bear the pain of illness or injury. Yet when lived with faith, these trials become opportunities for purification—for ourselves and others. "Offer it up" is no longer a cliché but a sacred reminder to unite our hearts and minds with God in our suffering. Today, let us pray for all the souls in Purgatory—that they may soon behold the glorious face of our Savior—and may they, in turn, pray for us, that we too may one day share eternal joy in Heaven.

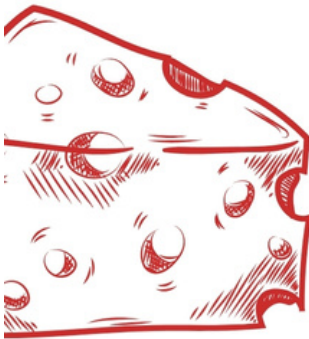
