SAINT MARTIN DE PORRES (1579-1639)

n old illustration pictures Martin Martin de Porres, finger to his lips—"Shhhh!"—as several mice peek out of sacristy vestment drawers, preparing to join a rodent "procession" following him out of church! Martin's rescue of statues depicting him, broom in mouse from the same Dominicans because of "mixed race" Christ he adored for hours in the

cherished society's marginalized. For him, menial tasks, lovingly done, were sacred. Great and lowly alike feasted on his charity. Enemies were reconciled by this "poor mulatto" (his self-description), kind even to those whose racism these unwelcome "guests," and demeaned him. Apprenticed to a surgeon-barber in his youth-thus hand, feeding a dog, cat, bird, and patron saint of hair stylists and dish public health providers-Martin symbolize his life and sanctity. dispensed healing and dignity to Initially denied entrance by the Lima's poorest serving in them the
